


## Secondary Transfer:



- Every parent must fill in the online Birmingham application form for their child <u>Click here</u>
- Choose 6 schools, in priority order. Look at the admission criteria carefully.
- Make sure that you note any brothers or sisters already at the same school
- The form must be completed by 31st October 2020
- You can amend your preferences right up to **11.59 pm** on the closing date (31 October 2020).
- **IMPORTANT:** if you amend your preferences, please ensure you re-submit your application form before the closing date otherwise your application will not be processed.




- You <u>must</u> choose 6 schools
- Put the schools you would like in the order you want your child to go to
- Every child who applies to a school will be ranked based on how closely they meet the school's <u>admissions arrangements</u>
- After the closing date of **31 October 2020**, applications will be processed. If you apply late you may be less likely to get a place at one of your preferred schools. More information will be available about late applications after the closing date.





## Admission Policy


Every school has an admission policy.



- You <u>MUST</u> apply separately online <a href="http://www.pahigh.co.uk/">http://www.pahigh.co.uk/</a> as well as choose 6 other choices on the Birmingham City Council application
- PA High does not appear as one of the school choices on the Birmingham form
- Essentially, you are applying to 2 different organisations, Birmingham City Council and PACT. You may then be offered a place at 2 schools: in this situation you will need to accept only 1 of them.
- If applying for PA High via paper application, post to the address on the envelope yourself or return to Heathfield School.
- When will I know if my application has been successful?
   Once you have completed your application form, we will contact parents/carers to inform them of offers on March 1st 2021. Families will then have until 15 March 2021 to accept/refuse the offer.

• Our admissions process opened on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020 and the closing date for applications will be October 31<sup>st</sup> 2020. To apply for September 2021 you will need to complete **two** application forms which include a form for Prince Albert Community Trust and a form to the local authority.

## **Grammar Schools**

#### **Applying for grammar schools**

- The test results for The Grammar Schools in Birmingham will be released before the 31<sup>st</sup> October.
- If your child gained the required mark, you must list it as one of your preferences in your online application.
- Preferably place 1 of your 6 choices, for example:
- Birmingham Grammar School A
- Birmingham Grammar School B
- School C
- School D
- School E
- School F

### Grammar School Admissions policy

- All pupils will be admitted solely on the basis of performance in the test.
- You will receive your child's test score by **check dates** by email or post. The letter will indicate the scores required for admission to each of the schools in the previous three years.
- Parents/carers can then decide whether or not to include any of the Grammar Schools in Birmingham on their home Local Authority preference form.
- Grammar schools need to be above other Birmingham City Council schools (1-6 priority order) on the application form

## When will I find out which secondary school my child has been allocated a place at?

- If you applied online and provided an email address, you will be emailed on 1 March 2021 to tell you which secondary school your child has been offered. We expect that you will receive your offer email by 4pm on Monday 1 March 2021.
- Birmingham City Council will also send you a formal offer letter that will be posted 1st class on **Monday 1 March 2021**. Please allow at least **three working days** for your letter to arrive.
- The deadline for accepting the place is 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021.
- If you wish to submit an appeal, the deadline for this is 29<sup>th</sup> March 2021.

## Proof of address

Acceptable proof of your child's home address for their school application, include:

- A copy of your council tax bill
- A copy of a recent utility bill (gas, water, electric, dated within the last 6 months
- A solicitors letter stating that contracts have been exchanged and specifying a completion date
- A copy of your Child Tax Credit or Working Tax Credit award letter (if you receive either of these benefits)
- A signed and dated tenancy agreement of not less than 12 months, plus proof residency e.g. a copy of recent utility bill

## Virtual Open Evenings

- Choose schools wisely
- Visit websites and do research
- Check virtual open evening dates

 Speak to your child about the choices you are going to make based on your preferences and theirs

## Things to consider before applying:

- Visit the schools' websites
- Consider how close you live to a school. Schools have <u>cut-off</u> <u>distances</u>, which change each year based on demand.
- However, some schools do have different criteria re intake.
- Most schools do accept sibling claims but this does not always guarantee a place for your child.
