

# ENGLISH

The children will be exploring the text 'Big People, Little Dreams Rosa Parks.' In guided reading, the children will be focusing on developing their intonation, expression and fluency further. They will also focus on reading around hard words. The children will develop their understanding of a range of vocabulary in fiction and non-fiction texts.

In writing, we will be covering a range of different pieces, starting with writing an informal letter and then looking at narratives. Children will unpick the features of a modelled text, identify the impact on the reader and then plan and write their own.

# MATHS

This term, the children will be delivering into the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division). This will include learning different strategies, solving various problems and enhancing their reasoning techniques. The children will have lots of opportunities to access this practically before moving onto it abstractly. Timetables practise will also be taught throughout.

# P.E.

This term, the children in 2G will be learning different fundamentals skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping. Children in 2P will be exploring and developing basic gymnastic actions on the floor and using apparatus. All children will be given the opportunity to work collaboratively with others, taking turns and sharing ideas.



# HUMANITIES

This term, the children are continuing to learn about significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national or international achievements. From this, they will compare different aspects of life in different periods. Also, they will understand the methods of historical enquiry, including how evidence is used to make historical claims.



# YEAR 2 AUTUMN TERM 2

# DT

This term children will be focusing on food technology. They will be identifying where food comes from, look at different tools and understanding that they have characteristics that make them suitable for specific purposes. They will also be reading and following recipes to make a dessert.



# MUSIC

This term, children will be learning how to hold the recorder correctly and stand in the correct position. They will learn how to play note B and A clearly and in time, as well as explaining what rhythm means.

# SCIENCE

This term, the children will be learning about habitats. This will include describing and comparing different habitats, identifying various animals and plants that live in certain habitats and looking at adaptations that help to protect animals and plants. Children will also be gathering data and presenting them in effective ways.



# COMPUTING

This term, children will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing and improving photos. Finally, they will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.



# RE AND PSHE

In PSHE, the children will be exploring the term bullying. They will discuss what this means and what they can do about it. In RE, they children will be learning how people respond to suffering. They will discover how the Prophets in Islam relived suffering through miracles given by Allah.
