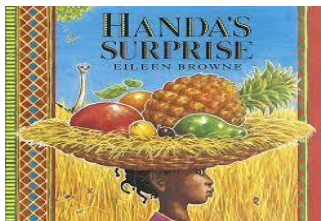


COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

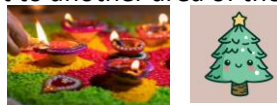
This term the children will be learning to follow instructions that has more than one part. They will also be working on communicating their needs using small sentences. Children will learn new vocabulary from the story Handa's Surprise' and key vocabulary about Safari Animals.



UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

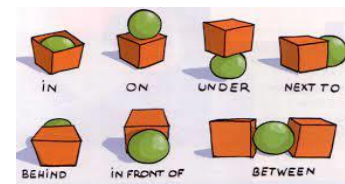
Nursery will be learning religious events and festivals through exploring Christmas and Diwali. Children will also begin to talk about and name the body parts of animals and ways to care for animals.

They will also describe how the weather and animals of where we live are different to another area of the world.



MATHS

Children will be learning how to subitise objects up to 5. They will use a range of animals they see on the interactive white board. They will also learn the mathematical language that relate to shapes, such as round, edges, sides and corners. Children will also understand prepositions, such as on top, underneath, beside and in front.



LITERACY

This term the children will learn about environmental sounds and body percussion in their phonic sessions. We will look at a range of African music and follow the rhythm as well as making up our own rhythms. Children will also learn how to handle a book with care, understand the features of a book and how to turn pages correctly. We will also be working on writing the initial letters of children's names.

NURSERY AUTUMN TERM 2

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

Children will be exploring colour mixing with a range of primary colours to make new colours. This term they will learn how to 'Write Dance' to the rhythm of African music and look at the patterns they have created.

They will listen with increased attention to sounds instruments make. They will then play instruments with increasing control.



PSED

Children will talk about their interests, needs and opinions. They will learn that everyone is special and different. They will learn to play with other children and build positive relationships. Children will follow and remember rules without needing an adult.

Children will learn the social skill of showing awareness of others and to keep themselves safe during physical activity. This term they will explore ball games and how to rolls a ball to a friend of their own choice.
