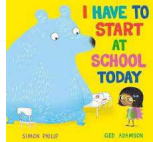


# ENGLISH

This term the class text will be 'I have to start at school today'. The text will help the children explore different emotions that they go through when starting a new school. It will also inspire the children's writing. They will be learning to create narratives within a familiar settings with the purpose to inform and entertain.

Following this, they will also learn how to write poetry. The children will look



at the key features of a poem and write their own poems using the school setting as their inspiration. They will also be revisiting writing recounts.

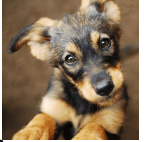
# HUMANITIES

This term, the children will continue with the topic of 'School Days'. They will be looking at what it was like living in the Victorian era, particularly at what school life was like. They will then compare schooling in the Victorian era to their experiences today.



# SCIENCE

This term, children will be looking at the topic 'Animal Parts'. They will identify and classify the different groups of animals, including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, mammals and invertebrates. The children will identify and describe their common structures, diets, and how animals should be cared for. The children will be introduced to a class pet, to generate scientific questions about it, using research and observation.



# MATHS

This term, children will be looking at numbers from 0-20. The children will use their knowledge of addition and subtraction within 10 to solve problems to 20. They will also use quantities to represent different numbers within 20. The children will be looking at measurements. They will be measuring items using cm, as well as measuring and estimating different lengths.

# DT

This term, the children will explore the topic 'Chop, Slice and Mash.' The children will be looking at where food comes from and the different food groups they belong to. They will be looking at the different utensils and items used to prepare food, so it is ready to eat. The children will be using their skills to make a salad and a sandwich.

# COMPUTING

This term, children will use technology purposefully to create their first film. The children will explore how to record and edit a basic video, using the Clips app. They will get the chance to add titles and filters to change the mood and feeling of the video.

# PE

This term, children will be introduced to Athletics, where children will be running and jumping long distance and height. They will also take part in 'striking and fielding skills, where they will be throwing, catching, bowling, batting and tracking the ball.

# MUSIC

This term children will be composing music using exploring themes. The children will be looking at the story of Peter and the Wolf and composing music using different tempos for different parts of the story.

# RE AND PSHE

This term in PSHE the children will learn about 'looking after each other and the world'. They will learn about how they should treat one another and the responsibilities they have. They will also be looking at how to manage change when moving to a new class. In RE, we will be looking at 'being curious and valuing knowledge' and 'being open and honest.'
