

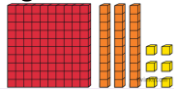
ENGLISH

The children will be exploring the text 'James and the Giant Peach.' In guided reading, the children will be focusing on word reading and fluency, using their phonics knowledge to read alternative sounds and decode unfamiliar words. They will also retell and sequence events from different texts.

In writing, we will be covering a range of different pieces, starting with a setting description and then looking at a character description. Children will unpick the features of a modelled text, identify the impact on the reader and then plan and write their own.

MATHS

This term, the children will learn about numbers and place value. The children will be furthering their understanding on recognising numbers up to 100 and representing them in numerous ways, counting in multiples of 10 and ordering and comparing numbers. The children will then move onto addition and subtraction, where they will solve problems involving up to 2-digit numbers. Timetables practise will also be taught throughout.



PE

This term, they'll explore a variety of activities aimed at enhancing different aspects of their health and fitness. The children will focus on enhancing their balance, running, jumping, hopping, and skipping abilities. They will discuss what happens to their bodies whilst exercising.



HUMANITIES

This term, children will learn about the historically significant people who have had a major impact on the world. They will discover how to use timelines, stories and historical sources to find out about people featured and use historical models to explore their significance.



YEAR 2 AUTUMN TERM 1

ART

This term children will be drawing, painting and sculpting natural forms of art from their observation, imagination and memory. Additionally, they will identify and mix secondary colours as well as evaluating their own and other members of their class's artwork using artistic vocabulary.



MUSIC

This term, children will begin to develop their recorder technique, accuracy and competency. They will learn how to read a stave and other relevant notations and develop playing in time and in tune.

SCIENCE

This term, the children will learn about human survival. This will include the stages of human development, what humans need to survive, the importance of a healthy lifestyle and personal hygiene. The children will also learn how to gather and record simple data and present them in an effective way as well as being able to notice patterns/relationships within their data.



COMPUTING

This term, children will develop their understanding of what information technology (IT) is and will begin to identify examples. They will discuss what they have seen in IT and will investigate how IT improves our world. Lastly, they will learn about the importance of using IT responsibly.



RE AND PSHE

In PSHE, children will learn about the importance of equality, focusing on what makes us similar and different. They will learn how and why we respect differences. In RE, children will learn about the importance of rules. They will explore why we have rules and the benefits of following them. They will also identify different rules people follow in Islam and why.
