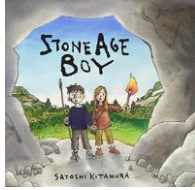


ENGLISH

This term, children will revisit their punctuation skills and then expand their writing abilities by incorporating a wider range of conjunctions, noun phrases, and sentence openers. They will apply these skills to create different types of texts inspired by our class text, "The Stone Age Boy."

In reading, the children will focus on strengthening their retrieval abilities. Additionally, they will explore diverse strategies for comprehending the meanings of unfamiliar words.



HUMANITIES

This term, the children will learn about realm of British prehistory, spanning from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. They will uncover how ingenuity, intervention and technological progress shaped the lives and lifestyles of ancient Britons. The children will also be introduced to the world of Bell Beaker Folk and deepen their understanding of concepts related to wealth and power.



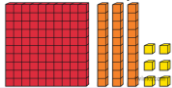
SCIENCE

This term, the children will learn about the importance of nutrition for humans and for other animals. Including how animals can be carnivores, herbivores or omnivores, needing food, water, air shelter, sleep and space to reproduce and survive. They will also learn about the role of a skeleton and muscles along with identifying animals with different types of skeleton.



MATHS

This term, the children will learn about numbers and place value. The children will focus on developing their partitioning, ordering and comparing to 1000. Furthermore, they'll strengthen their multiplication knowledge throughout. The children will move onto addition and subtraction, where they will solve problems involving up to 3-digit numbers, which may involve the concepts of exchanging and regrouping.



YEAR 3 AUTUMN TERM 1

ART

This term children will learn about the colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. This includes an exploration of tertiary colours, warm and cool colours, complementary colours and analogous colours, and how artists use colour in their artwork.



PE

This term, the children in 3B will dive into the world of fitness. They'll explore a variety of activities aimed at enhancing different aspects of their health and fitness. In 3J, the children will focus on enhancing their balance, running, jumping, hopping, and skipping abilities.



MUSIC

This term children will be learning different notes and songs on the recorders, whilst also focusing on the beat and pitch.



COMPUTING

This term, children will develop their understanding of digital devices. They will also compare digital and non-digital devices. They will also be introduced to computer networks. Lastly, learners will discover the benefits of connecting devices in a network.



RE AND PSHE

In PSHE, children will learn about the importance of friendships, knowing how to build good friendships and how to manage them. In RE, children will learn about the importance of sharing and how it can make others feel. Along with what different religions believe about sharing.
