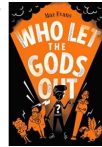


ENGLISH

This term children will continue to read 'Who let the Gods out' by Max Evans as well as looking at a non-fiction text about Ancient Greeks linking to our history topic. Children will continue to look at a range of different question types to prepare them for next year. In writing, children will be further developing their writing skills through our daily grammar starters and applying this knowledge to a range of different writes including: a one-sided argument; formal letter; non-chronological report and a poem.



HUMANITIES

This term children will continue to learn about the Greeks. This project teaches children about developments and changes over six periods of ancient Greek history, focusing on the city state of Athens in the Classical age, and exploring the lasting legacy of ancient Greece. We will focus on inventions we still use today, as well as comparing aspects of ancient Greek life to our own.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

SCIENCE

This term children will be learning about Earth and Space. Within this project the children will learn about the solar system and its spherical celestial bodies. The children will be describing the movement of the Earth and the other planets around the Sun. The children will be learning about the relationship between the moon and Earth. We will be investigating the Earth's rotation in order to explain day and night.



MATHS

In maths this half term, we will continue to learn about fractions, moving on to solving problems. We will then move on to converting units. This will use a range of skills to convert between different units of measure and even convert between miles and kilometres and other metric to imperial measuring units. If there is time before the end of the school year we will focus on angles, revising right angles, with other types and solving a range of problems involving angles.

THE ARTS

This term children will learn about architecture in our DT lessons. This project teaches children about how architectural style and technology has developed over time and then use this knowledge to design a building with specific features. We will look at influences of other cultures to base our designs and build up to design an impressive, yet functional, building.

COMPUTING

This term children will learn how to play tough instruments in GarageBand (iPad app) to explore progression in popular songs. Children will learn to build a song by layering different instruments.

This term children will continue to glockenspiel and develop their the Fresh Prince of Bel Air.
