

LITERACY

This term the children will be focusing on 'The Gingerbread Man' and 'Mog's Christmas'. Children will be encouraged to listen and play alongside each other. Children will be developing their fine motor skills through showing control in holding and using resources such as jugs to pour, books and mark making tools.



Recommendation: Practise name writing at home.

EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

In Nursery the children will be encouraged use movement to express feelings and create movement in response to music. They will be developing an interest in the way musical instruments sound. We will be exploring colours and how they can be changed, alongside exploring and learning how sounds can be changed.

Recommendations: Begin to use objects to construct, stack blocks, create spaces and make enclosures.

PSED

The children will be encouraged to select and use activities and resources with help. They will also continue to grow their confidence to talk to other children when playing and will communicate freely about their own home and community. Children will also begin to accept the needs of others and will take turns and share resources, sometimes with support.

MATHS

The children will be learning how to recite number names in sequence through number rhymes and daily counting. They will also be focusing on learning to recognise numbers 0-10. They will be encouraged to select a small number of objects from a group. The children will begin to make comparisons between quantities.



NURSERY AUTUMN TERM 1-2

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD



The children will be developing their knowledge and understanding of the world through exploring our environment and small world models.

We will begin to learn about different celebrations from different religions. This term we will be discussing and exploring different activities related to Diwali and Christmas.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Children will begin to show an understanding of prepositions such as: 'under', 'on top' and 'behind' by carrying out an action or selecting the correct picture. They will also be encouraged to use talk to connect ideas, explain what is happening and anticipate what might happen next, recall and relive past experiences.



P.E

This term our topic is Dance. Children will be developing their expressive movement through the topic of 'everyday life'. Children will explore space and how to use space safely. They will explore travelling movements, shapes, and balances. Children will choose their own actions in response to a stimulus. They will be given the opportunity to copy, repeat and remember actions. They will be introduced to counting to help them keep in time with the music.

HOME LEARNING

Take your child for an autumn walk and collect props to create a picture of their choice.

TECHNOLOGY

Children will have the opportunity to use the interactive whiteboard to mark make. We will also be discovering Spheros and Bee-Bots to explore sense of direction.
