

ENGLISH

This term the children will be revisiting their writing skills looking at adjectives and conjunctions in order to write a poem and describe a setting. As a class we will be reading the poetry book, 'Gargling with Jelly', we will then be reading 'How Winston delivered Christmas'. This will lead to the children using a range of persuasive writing.



HUMANITIES

This term the children will be doing Geography and will be learning all about the United Kingdom. They will be looking at the four different countries that make up the UK. We will also be learning how to use a map and an atlas to locate different counties and to become familiar with different map symbols.



SCIENCE AND DT

This term the children will be studying animals including humans to look at nutrition and the different amount of food that humans and animals have to consume. The children will also be looking at muscles, skeletons and how the human body works.



MATHS

This term the children will be focusing on addition and subtraction of up to 3 digit numbers. They will be learning lots of different methods to get to the correct answer. Then, we will look at multiplication and the different methods to work out multiplication questions.

THE ARTS

This term the children will be focusing on the artist Angela Lewin. They will be looking at how to create a reusable print by using mono-print, block print and relief print.



COMPUTING

This term the children will become programmers. They will be using Scratch and looking into the different codes that they need to get the character to move. They will also be learning how to change the colour of the character.



PE

This term the children will be developing their fitness, coordination, flexibility, strength and agility skills. They will be learning about the movement of the body.
