

ENGLISH

This term the children will be learning about architecture. We will be focusing on the artists Zaha Hadid and Norman Foster. Children will get to experiment with different drawing techniques and styles.



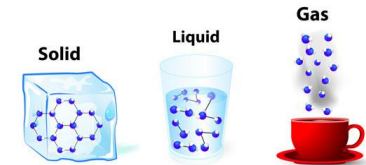
MUSIC
