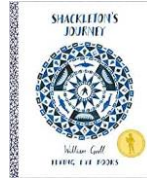


ENGLISH

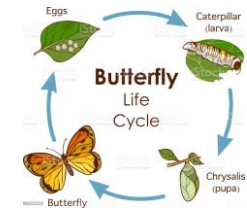
HUMANITIES
