EUGUSU

This half term the children will continue reading *Pig Heart Boy by Malorie Blackman*. They will be applying their reading skills (mostly retrieval, inference, prediction and summary) through comprehension activities. In writing, we will be developing our writing skills through the context of a balanced

argument and narrative. We will also routinely work on relevant grammar and punctuation.



MATUS

This half term, the children will be reviewing their knowledge of decimals and percentages and discovering the importance of understanding the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. They will continue to look at reasoning and problem solving questions as well as working on raw maths and fluency. They will prepare for the SATs tests in May by practising test style questions.

P.E

This term the children will be learning about dodgeball. They should wear their full PE uniform to school on their day.

CHUMANITHES

The children will consider the impact of WW2 on not just Britain but the entire world. They will focus on the countries that constitute to the make up of the commonwealth. They will explore how the commonwealth was formed, its impact and how it still exists today. They will create chronological reports of events that took place and compare them to British history. The children will also develop their historical vocabulary of this topic and use it in their interpretations.



THE ABTS

This term the children will be learning about how they can make their observational drawings realistic. They will be inspired by the work of Leonardo Da Vinci.

MUSI6

All the learning for this half term is focused on 'A New Year Carol' and the children will be using the glockenspiels to play the song. This is a sixweek unit of work that builds on previous learning.



science and D.T

This half term the children will be learning about LIGHT. They will use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they can give out or reflect light into the eye.



GOMPUTING

This half term the children will continue to focus on micro-bit programming. The children will be learning constant and changing variables. This unit will allow children to build upon previous coding knowledge whilst using a more advanced piece of technology.
