
ELGLISH

This term the children will continue learning about non-fiction texts using the book – 'The magic and mystery of Trees'. They will create information booklets of their own using common features that they have identified. Later in the term the children will read the text – 'The true story of the 3 little pigs'. The children will consider the concept of a fractured fairy tale and create fractured fairy tales of their own. They will develop their narrative writing skills.

BITTAM

In maths, pupils will be focusing on number. They will be recalling place value but focusing on addition and subtraction. They will be exposed to some formal methods as well as using the concrete, pictorial and abstract strategy. Pupils will also be number, words counters

exposed to money in the context of adding and subtracting.



P.E

This term in PE, the topics are Fitness and Ball skills. They will develop their use of fitness routines and the way they affect our bodies. In Ball skills the children will explore: rolling, catching and dribbling.

COMMITTEE

This half term the children will be focusing on a history topic called: Queens in charge — Elizabeth I, Victoria & Elizabeth II. The children will learn about these British female monarchs and their influence on society. They will use their chronology skills to place them in order of reign. Key events that they are remembered for or linked to will be learnt too. Using evidence they will consider what impact they had on their country and the world.

YEAR 2 SPRING TERM 2.1

THE ARTS

This term the children will be learning about the mixed media artist Jude Kingshott. They will be learning about how to create an effect by applying colour to fabric; creating their own dyes and learning different types of stitches. They will use this to create their own textiles art piece.

MUSIG



In Music this term, pupils will be learning the song called 'Friendship.' They will be using the glockenspiels to perform alongside the song.



SCIENCE AND D.T

In Science, pupils will be learning all about living things and their habitats (micro-habitats).



Children will learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. They will learn to tell the difference between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive, and apply this in a range of contexts.

COMPUTING

In this unit, the pupils will try to work out how some simple Scratch games work. They will also look at free online or open source games and share their favourite games with the class.
