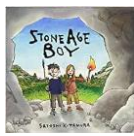



ENGLISH

This term the children will be revisiting their punctuation skills before using a wider range of adjectives and verbs to tell a story! We are going back in time to the Stone Age by reading the class texts Stone Age Boy and how to live like a Stone Age Hunter. They will be improving their comprehension and inference skills through class discussions and learning how to write a longer written response to a reading question.



HUMANITIES

This term the children will be learning about life from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. They will consider where the time period fits into their historical knowledge by using a timeline. Then, they will learn more about life in these times and compare it to the present day.

Prehistory timeline 

The Early Stone Age (Paleolithic) 500,000 BC - 8000 BC	The Middle Stone Age (Mesolithic) 8000 BC - 4000 BC	The Late Stone Age (Neolithic) 4000 BC - 2500 BC	The Bronze Age 2500 BC - 700 BC	The Iron Age 700 BC - AD 45
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MATHS

This term the children will be revising their 2, 10 and 5 times tables, and moving onto learning their 3 and 4 times tables. They will also revisit their place value learning on tens and ones before moving on to hundreds, tens and ones.

THE ARTS

This term the children will be considering how to make a model animal look realistic and lifelike.

They will use a variety of modelling skills such as rolling and indenting.



P.E

This term the children will be learning to stretch and relax their body through yoga. They will also work on improving their stamina as we build up to walking 3 kilometres round the local area.



MUSIC

This term, children will be introduced to recorders and how to play notes of different pitch.



SCIENCE AND D.T

This term the children will be learning all about different types of rocks. They will discover the different types of rocks in their area, consider how they feel and their other properties before learning all the scientific vocabulary.



COMPUTING

This term the children will be revisiting how to stay safe when using technology. They will then revisit the basics of producing digital products using MS Publisher, before moving on to producing more complex documents using a greater variety of tools and skills.



RE AND PSHE

This term in RE the children will learn about the symbolism of light and dark in different faiths and the ideas of good and evil. In PHSE, we are learning about how to be a good friend, including how to manage and resolve conflict.
