

ENGLISH

This term the children will be reading *Skellig* by David Almond. They will be practising their reading skills (retrieval, inference, prediction etc.) through comprehension activities.

For writing, we will be developing our writing skills through the context of character descriptions and dialogue action scenes. We will also focus on a range of grammar and punctuation skills such as an awareness of the impact of metaphors, personification and other types of figurative language on our writing.

MATHS

This term the children will be reviewing their knowledge of place value up to ten million and discovering the importance of place value when using the four operations. They will continue to look at reasoning and problem solving questions as well as working on fluency. Children should know their times tables up to 12 x 12 and will be expected to practise at least three times a week at home.

P.E

This term the children will be learning about fitness. They should wear their full PE uniform to school on their day. No branded sportswear should be worn.

MUSIC

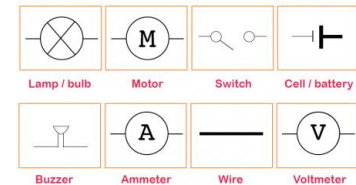
In music this half term we will be playing the glockenspiels, starting with notation and simple tunes.

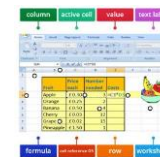
SCIENCE AND D.T
