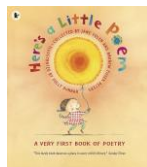
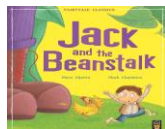


ENGLISH

This term the children will be reading the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. They will be writing invitations and stories. They will use question and exclamation marks when writing their stories. The children will continue focusing on their sentence structure. We will be focusing on handwriting using precursive letter formation. The children will explore poems from the book: 'Here's a Little Poem'. They will be writing their own acrostic poems.



HUMANITIES

The children will learn about the depths of the ocean and compare how deep different oceans are compared to each other. They will discuss the importance of oceans in our world. The children will explore what lives in the ocean and learn that it is a habitat for many different species of sea creatures. They will then take on the role of activists and consider why our oceans are under threat and what more we can do to protect them.

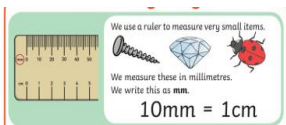
SCIENCE

This term the children will be learning about plants. They will be learning how plants grow, the different parts of a plant and what they do. The children will be exploring what plants need to grow and will also have the opportunity to plant their own fruit, vegetable and flower seeds and watch them grow. They will also be discovering facts about plants and the different families they belong to.



MATHS

This term the children will be learning all about measuring. We will be focusing on comparing a range of objects and identifying which are 'longer' or 'shorter' than others. The children will also compare, describe and solve practical problems for mass and weight. They will be using the terminology 'heavy', 'light', 'full', 'empty' and 'quarter'.

ART AND D & T

This term the children will be completing a design and technology project. They will be creating an animal puppet using a range of suitable fabrics and materials. The children will design their puppet and use their sewing techniques to create a final design.



COMPUTING

This term the children will learn how to use Microsoft Powerpoint to retell and create their own talking book stories. They will use recording equipment to record sounds and develop skills in saving and storing sounds on the laptops. They will share their final talking book with the class and reflect on their use of ICT.

PE

This term, the children will be exploring their gymnastic skills. They will develop their concentration and flexibility in their muscles. The children will also continue to explore the fundamental ball skills such as rolling the ball, dribbling and catching.

MUSIC

This term the children will be learning the song 'In the Grove', they will accompany this with the music created with glockenspiels.

RE AND PSHE

This term in RE the children will be learning about being courageous. They will learn this through stories of different faiths and their own experience. In PSHE, the children will be exploring how to use money and how it can be obtained.
