

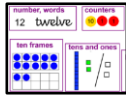


ENGLISH



This term the children will continue to develop their narrative writing. They will consider different parts of a story and plan/write using it to guide their stories. Later in the term, they will move onto our next text: Traction Man. Within this text they will learn about the conjunction 'when'. They will use it within their writing to inform – through report writing as well as in alliterative/adjectival poems. In reading, the children will practise retrieval and inference.

MATHS



This term the children will focus on the topic 'number and measurement'. This will include multiplication, division and money. Pupils will begin to understand 'how'. They will be using concrete materials to represent their calculations and consider doing the same pictorially. Eventually, pupils will apply their learning to questions independently.



P.E

This term in PE, the topics are Fitness and Gymnastics. Pupils will be focusing on stamina and using their bodies in different ways to ensure they stay fit.



HUMANITIES

This half term the the children will learn about different types of settlements. They will consider how settlements are shaped/ formed as well as how they are occupied. They'll know that villages, towns and cities are all types of settlements and vary due to different factors. They will conduct comparisons between villages and cities. Finally, the children will compare a UK city/ village to a city/ village in Bangladesh.

D&T



This term the children will be completing a project based on a balanced diet. They will be creating their own wrap and will be researching the design and testing the different types of foods available.

MUSIC

In music, the children will be focusing on the song 'Zoo time.' They will be using the glockenspiels for this unit.

SCIENCE



This term pupils will be learning about animals including humans. They will begin by looking at animals when they are young and comparing them to their adults. They will look at how animals change as they grow up and be introduced to the life cycles of several varied common animals, including humans. They will look in detail at how humans change as they grow older, drawing on their own observations.

COMPUTING



This term the children will carry out a sequence of learning linked to the art of photography called: Everyone can create! The children will explore how different features within the camera app can be used to create different effects on photos. They will develop skills and for their final piece, personify an object using the skills acquired.

RE AND PSHE



This term in RE, the children will learn about caring for others, animals and the environment and being merciful and forgiving. In PSHE, pupils will be looking at how and why we should keep safe.
