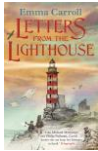


ENGLISH

This half term the children will continue reading *Letters from the lighthouse* by Emma Carroll. They will be applying their reading skills (mostly retrieval, inference, prediction and summary) through comprehension activities. In writing, we will be developing our writing skills through the context of narrative and poems. We will also routinely work on relevant grammar and punctuation.

This half term we will also spend some time becoming familiar with the question style of SATs papers.



HUMANITIES

The children will learn what are natural resources and where they can be found in the world. They will explore how the use of natural resources has changed/ developed over time and what impact they have in different countries. They will explore deeper into a chosen country about their specific resources and make comparisons to the UK. Finally, through learning about the circular economy, they will also consider how resource exploitation is causing a global problem.



SCIENCE AND D.T

This half term, the children will describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals.

They will also give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

MATHS

This half term, the children will be reviewing their knowledge of area and perimeter as well as recapping fractions, decimals and percentages. They will also look other areas of shape such as translation and reflection. They will continue to look at reasoning and problem solving questions as well as working on raw maths and fluency regularly. Times table knowledge is essential at this point.

DT

This term the children will looking at printing and painting. They will be exploring the key question: How could you create graffiti that would be seen as art and not vandalism?



COMPUTING

This half term the children will be focusing on using technology across the curriculum. They will develop their research skills and use ever more sophisticated searches when trying to find information. They will also present their work using the skills they have learnt across upper key stage two.

MUSIC

This is a unit of work that builds on previous learning. It is supported by weekly lesson plans and assessment. All the learning is focused on 'You've got a friend in me' and the children will be using the glockenspiels to play the song.

In RE, children will be learning about being regardful of suffering and being merciful and forgiving. The children will learn about different types of suffering and how Jesus was hurt on the cross.
