

ENGLISH

This term the children will be reading 'Coming to England' by Floella Benjamin. During reading lessons, we will be using the text to answer retrieval questions and look at inference.



In writing lessons, we will be learning how to write formally and create news reports. We will also be writing disaster stories with the purpose to entertain; therefore, we will look at developing our writing to be entertaining and engaging.

MATHS

This term the children will be focusing on fractions. Children will be introduced to fractions with a variety of denominators. We will be learning about equivalent fractions and how we add and subtract fractions. They will then be taught to calculate fractions of quantities.

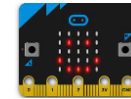
SCIENCE
