

ENGLISH

This term, the children will be reading and exploring the story 'Meerkat Mail'. They will be writing postcards to inform the reader about what a character is thinking and feeling. The children will then create an information text. They will identify and understand what a proper noun is through writing facts about meerkats. The children will also take part in an unprepared write where they will be given visuals as a stimulus. They will be encouraged to use their knowledge of adjectives to entertain the reader and describe a setting. To end the year, they will write a diary entry to reflect on an experience.



HUMANITIES - GEOGRAPHY

This term, the children will learn about fieldwork in our school. They will learn what fieldwork is and use simple fieldwork techniques and observational skills to study the geography of Heathfield Primary School.

The children will generate a question they want answered by fieldwork about Heathfield School. Then, they will then plan out how to answer the question. After that they will observe and record their findings through pictures and drawings before presenting them to others.



Heathfield PRIMARY SCHOOL

SCIENCE

This term, the children will be consolidating their learning about plants and seasons. They will continue to identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. The children will continue to explore the four seasons. They will observe changes across the four seasons and describe weather associated with the seasons and how the day length varies.



MATHS

This term, the children will be learning about place value to 100. They will represent numbers on a place value grid then complete sentences to compare the given numbers. They will also be learning fractions. Children will use their knowledge to split various shapes into halves. They will use their knowledge of halving to complete number sentences using dominoes then progress to creating their own domino problems. The children will be telling time to the hour and will indicate which hour comes before and after the given hour too.

YEAR 1 SUMMER TERM 3.2

ART

This term, the children will be exploring the artist, David Hockney. They will be focusing on landscape and seasons. They will be experimenting with watercolour paints focusing on how different brush sizes create different effects. Also, identifying primary colours and secondary colours and investigating what happens when you mix colours.



COMPUTING

This term, the children will learn how to record and edit a simple video clip using an iPad. They will learn how to tell a story on the app using engaging visuals. The children will be taught how to record and edit a simple video using the Clips app on the iPad. They will learn to crop and adjust colour and sound levels as well as adding titles to their video.



PE

This term, the children will continue exploring their contemporary dance skills and perform at the Midlands Art Exhibition. The children will also participate in Athletics where they will practice running, jumping and throwing. Also, they will participate in sports week to celebrate the Commonwealth Games.

MUSIC

This term, the children will be learning the song 'Your Imagination'. This will be done through singing and playing the glockenspiel.

RE AND PSHE

This term in RE, the children will continue learning about what followers of Islam look forward to and how to value the truth. In PSHE, the children will continue to learn about people who help us to keep safe. They will also learn about how we can look after each other and the world.
