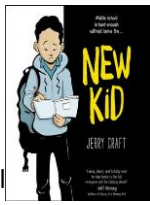


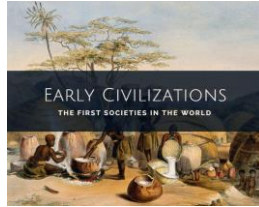
# ENGLISH

This half term, we will continue reading a book filled with short stories and poems called 'Once upon a Place' and our new book 'New Kid'. In writing, the children will be exploring and then writing their own war poems. We will also be studying 'Darwin's Tree of Life' and children will write a persuasive campaign. In reading, children will be applying the many reading skills they have learnt in Key Stage 2. Towards the end of the half term, we will be increasing practice on all the skills necessary for reading aloud with fluency.



# HUMANITIES

The children will continue to focus upon the formation of early civilisations as well as their achievements. For example, in mathematics, government, trade, building and art. In geography, children will use fieldwork to observe, measure and record the features of South America. They will represent human and physical features using digital technologies and 6 figure grid references.



# SCIENCE

This half term, the children will continue learning about evolution and inheritance. They will learn how living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago. They will also identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.



# MATHS

This half term, the children will be reviewing their knowledge of statistics and measurement and algebra. They will continue to work on reasoning and problem solving questions to demonstrate their depth of understanding of mathematical concepts. Children will also continuously be applying knowledge and skills through fluency and raw maths questions, building up speed. It is of high importance that every child is continuing to develop their times tables knowledge and pace.

# DT

Structures: This topic draws upon pupils' skills and knowledge of structures, challenging them to design and create a model of a new playground featuring five apparatus, made from three different structures.



# COMPUTING

This half term children will learn how to produce a short narrative film. This will involve writing a screenplay (script) in Pages, then using Keynote to create a floorplan for their filming, as well as edit and mix sound effects in iMovie for their final video.
