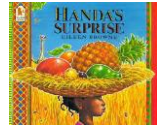


LITERACY

This term the children will be focusing on the text: 'Have you seen elephant?' and 'Handa's Surprise'.

Children will be ascribing meanings to marks they see in different places and giving meaning to marks they draw and paint. They will begin to be aware of different parts of the book, such as title, front cover and blurb.



Recommendation: Practise name writing at home.

EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

In Nursery, the children will be encouraged to use movement to express feelings in response to music. The children will be exploring and learning how sounds and colours can be changed.

Recommendations: Begin to use objects to construct, stack, create spaces and make enclosures.



PSED

Children in Nursery will begin to adapt to their behaviour to different events, social situations and changes in routine. We will also be focusing on children becoming more outgoing towards unfamiliar people and more confident in new social situations.



MATHS

The children will begin to match numeral to quantity correctly and show curiosity about numbers by offering comments or asking questions. The children will be able to use shapes appropriately in play and complete jigsaw puzzles.



NURSERY SUMMER TERM 3.2

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

The children will be developing their knowledge and understanding of the world through exploring our outdoor environment. We will be planting a range of vegetables and flowers to encourage children to discuss the changes they observe and show care and concern for living things and the environment.



Children will explore similarities and differences, pattern and change in the world around them.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Children will begin to understand the use of objects (e.g. What do we use to cut things?)

They will begin to understand 'why' and 'how' questions and respond to simple instructions. They will begin to use more complex sentences to link thoughts. The children will begin to build up their vocabulary to reflect the breadth of their experiences.

P.E

This term the children will be encouraged to move freely with pleasure and confidence. This will be done in a range of ways such as shuffling, rolling, walking, running, jumping and hopping.



Children will begin to hold the pencil near the point between the first two fingers and thumb and use it with good control.

TECHNOLOGY

Children will have the opportunity to use Spheros to engage in a deeper sense of direction. The children will begin to know that information can be retrieved from computers and iPads.
