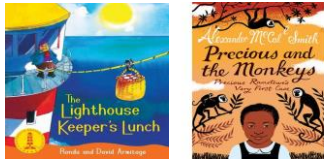


ENGLISH

This half term, the children will complete reading the book 'Precious and the Monkeys'. They will then learn about the conjunction 'when' as well as their understanding of main and subordinate clauses. Finally, we will move onto a new text called 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. Using their learnt skills they will apply their prior knowledge to narrative writing. In reading, the children will continue to develop their retrieval and inference skills.



HUMANITIES

This half term the children will conclude their history topic on the Cadbury Family by completing their KLT Booklets. They will then begin the geography topic all about fieldwork. They will learn about observational skills that are used to study the geographical makeup of school. They will consider what some of the key human & physical features can be found in the school and its surrounding areas.



SCIENCE

This term pupils will focus on their STEM Project using LEGO.

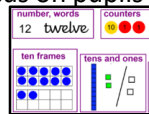


Alongside this, they will continue their learning about plants. This will include learning around: growth, identification, environmental effects and how to respond to enquiry questions.



MATHS

This term, the children will focus on the topic 'measurement' and 'geometry'. This will include reading the time on a clock to the nearest 15 / 5 minutes plus understanding and comparing durations of time. Along with, being able to describe a position, movement, turn and be able to make patterns with shapes. We will also be looking at measures of mass, capacity and volume. There will be a focus on pupils applying their learning independently.

D&T AND ART

This term, the children will be continuing with the Ferris wheel project for D&T. Then, they will then start their new art topic. They will focus on the artist Hurwin Anderson. Children explore primary colours and secondary colours through expressive mark making, connecting colour and texture using acrylic paint in an abstract form.



PE

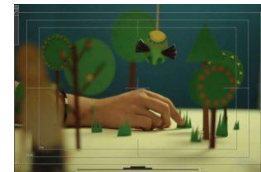
This half term in PE, the topics are Invasion Games and Athletics. Pupils will continue to focus on developing their understanding and skills in each of these areas.

COMPUTING

This half term, children will learn how to create a simple stop frame animation using plasticene models. Children will look at professionally made animations to identify how they are put together and then storyboard and create their own.

This term in RE, the children will explore different ideas of God and consider how beauty can be found in many forms. In PSHE, they will be focusing on how they can recognise their feelings. Mental health and growing up will be explored.
