

ENGLISH

This term, the children will be reading 'Wolves in the Walls' by Neil Gaiman and Frida Kahlo's biography.



During reading lessons, we will learn about how root word, prefixes and suffixes help us understand words in their contexts. After this, they will be developing their inference of motives and then recap their inference and retrieval skills.

In writing lessons, we will be writing a diary entry based on an image, mystery stories and a biography. Key skills we will be focusing on are using adverb openers, verbs, adjectives and adverbs to create pace, subordinate conjunctions and the consistent use of punctuation.

MATHS

This term, we will continue to work on fractions by finding out what equivalent fractions are and how to order fractions by size. Once this is completed, we will move onto identifying the characteristics of shapes. Then we will be investigating the different lengths, perimeters, mass and capacity of objects. Please make sure your child is practising their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars.

Year 3 children should know their 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables by the end of the year.

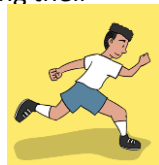


PE

This term, the children will be developing their athletic skills. Year 3 will be enhancing their sprinting, relay, jumping and throwing skills.

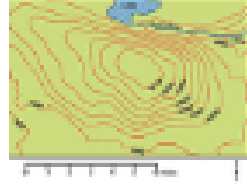
3PM PE kit on a Monday.

GEOGRAPHY

SCIENCE
