



ENGLISH

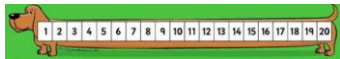


In Year 1, the children will also be exploring the story 'Biscuit Bear'. They will learn how to write instructions and we will be making our very own biscuit bears. We will also be exploring the story 'More people to love me'. The children will be discovering their family tree. The children will be using labels and captions to describe who is in their family.

We will be encouraging them to independently use capital letters, finger spaces and put full stops at the end of their sentences.

MATHS

This term the children will be learning to say numbers forwards and backwards from 0 to 100. They will use the language: 'equal to', 'more', 'less', 'greater than', 'fewer' and 'less than' to compare groups of objects. They will learn to identify 1 more and 1 less from a given number.



P.E

This term, the children will be exploring healthy eating and how to have a healthy lifestyle. During our PE lessons we will be learning a range of dance techniques and the fundamentals of PE. The children will need to come to school dressed in their correct PE uniform every Monday and Tuesday.

HISTORY

This term the children will be learning about the key events from their families and their own past. They will learn to identify how these events have impacted their own lives today. They will use the vocabulary and historical terms in their spoken and written work. The children will be asked to bring in photos from home to share with the class to show what life was like when their grandparents were young compared to their own photos of today.

ART

This term the children will be focusing on the artist Anwar Jalal Shemza. The children will learn how to print and experiment printing with different objects such as sponges, corks and reels. The children will create a building using the medium of print.



MUSIC

This term the children will be learning two different genre songs. They will be exploring the rhythm in songs and rap music.

SCIENCE

This term children will be learning to identify and label parts of the human body as well as, naming a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. They will identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. They will be describing and comparing the structure of a variety of common animals - fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals (including pets).

COMPUTING

This term children will learn about online safety, and identify unkind online behaviour that can upset people and how to avoid it. They will learn how to log on to the laptops, use an iPad and open a piece of software like 'Paint'. They will save their work and learn to retrieve it the next lesson.



RE AND PSHE

This term the children will be thinking about aspects of identity shown in their family, community and the choices they make. They will also be exploring what makes a good friend and why.
