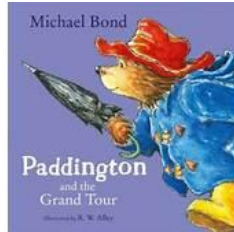


ENGLISH

This term the class text will be Paddington and the Grand Tour by Michael Bond. The children will be learning to write short narratives. They will also be exploring what a postcard is; how to write a postcard; and when to write a postcard. Alongside this the children will be at writing a non-chronological report which will be linked to their humanities topic.



HUMANITIES

In this geography project, children will build on their knowledge and will revisit the map of the United Kingdom and identify its four countries, their relative positions, their capital cities and the surrounding seas and oceans. They will learn about the term 'physical feature' and physical features of the UK. Then, they will learn about 'human features' in urban landscapes. A study of the main characteristics of London will occur along with map reading.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

SCIENCE

This term children will be learning about the four seasons and the typical weather and events associated with each season. We will be using key vocabulary such as 'evergreen' and 'deciduous'. We will also be identifying and classifying different trees. We will be learning how animals respond to seasonal change and look for patterns.



MATHS

This term children will recognise, compose, decompose and manipulate 2D and 3D shapes. They will look at shapes in and around their environment and use accurate mathematical terms to describe them in terms of their properties. The children will also develop and consolidate their knowledge of numbers 0-10.



YEAR AUTUMN TERM 2

THE ARTS

This term children will be introduced to the method of collagraph printmaking. We will be looking at the term 'motif' and will practise making simple weather motifs using transparent materials. We will be learning about different elements of line and shape. As well as learning about Transient art and creating their own by taking inspiration from the weather and Andy Goldsworthy.



P.E

This term children will be developing their gymnastic skills, which will help them to develop their balancing skills and flexibility. The children will also be doing yoga, which will help to calm body and minds.



MUSIC

This term children will be learning the song 'In the Groove'. We will be learning it in different styles including: Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk.

COMPUTING

This term children will be learning how to navigate Spheros using a touch pad. We will then further learning by creating a maze. Then we will apply the skills we have learnt to navigate the Spheros way around the maze.



RE AND PSHE

This term in PSHE the children will learn about staying healthy and everything they need to do to keep healthy. In RE, the children will learn about the dispositions of 'being fair and just' and 'being accountable and living with integrity'. They will learn about these through the Islamic and Christian perspective.
