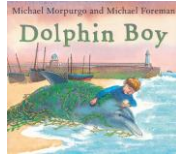


ENGLISH

This term's class text will be 'The Dolphin Boy'. This term in writing, we will begin with looking at what narratives are and the features of one, before they begin writing their own adventure narrative. After this, the children will recap the features of letters, before they write their own. Finally, the children will learn the features of a non-chronological reports and then have a go at writing one which will link to the book.

In reading, we will be looking at the same text and do a variety of different comprehension questions.



HUMANITIES

This term children will learn about the coastline. After this topic, they will be able to name and locate seas around the UK, describe location points using a compass, read and interpret a range of simple maps and carry out basic field work. The field work will involve map work as well as collecting data. They will also learn about the geographical features of the coastline and why it changes over time.



SCIENCE

This term children will learn about 'Uses of materials'. They will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. Then children will move onto identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

MATHS

This term children will be introduced to what multiplication is and the different ways to work out a multiplication calculation through grouping and repeated addition. After this topic, the children will then be introduced to division structure. Children will learn how items can be grouped equally to divide. This knowledge will then be used for pupils to workout division problems.

YEAR 2 SPRING 1

THE ARTS

This term they are learning about the visual elements of flowers, including shape, texture, colour, pattern and form. They also explore various artistic methods, including drawing, printmaking and 3-D forms, using paper and clay. There will be a focus on the artist Yayoi Kusama for inspiration for their art work.



COMPUTING

This term children will learn what algorithms are. They will understand how algorithms are implemented as programs on digital devices; and that programs work by following precise and clear instructions. As a final piece the children will create and debug simple programs.

P.E

This term children will learn fundamentals. They will learn the different ways of movement, develop their balance and develop their understanding about movement too. After this topic, the children will focus on dance. They will develop their understanding further about body movement and rhythm,.

MUSIC

This term children will continue to learn how to play their recorders. They will be learning how to play different notes on the recorders, playing along to different pieces of music.

RE AND PSHE

This term children will learn about what it means to Create Unity and Harmony. they will explore how are you both different from, yet the same as everyone else. They will learn about different religions and beliefs and how people promote / create unity and harmony.
