EUGLISU

This term's class text will be Firework Maker's Daughter by Phillip Pullman. This term in writing, the children will be exploring poetry, such as the features of and how to write a shape poem. After this, the children will learn the features of a non-chronological reports and write their own which will link to the book we are reading.

In reading, the children will be learning about what predictions are and how to sensibly make one based off the context of the book. As well as, PHILIP PULLMAN developing our vocabulary.

MATUS

This term children will learn about right angles, the features of a right angle and how to identify them in shapes. After this topic, the children will learn about the additive relationship and developing their mental addition and subtraction calculations to a secure level. Pupils will continue to practise their timetables (10, 2, 5, 3, 4 and 8).



P.B

This term children in 3B will be focusing on gymnastics. They will learn to develop their balance and a variety of gymnastic movement. The children in 3G will be focusing on dodgeball this term. They will begin to develop their throwing, catching and movement skills.



HUMANITIES

This term children will learn about rocks, relics and rumbles in geography. Children will learn about the structure and the characteristics of the Earth's layer, and how this impacts the tectonic plates. Also, children will learn about latitude and longitude lines and practise using them on a world map to locate volcanoes. Finally, pupils will be

introduced to earthquakes and learn about the causes and consequences.



YEAR 3 SPRING TERM 1

THE ARTS

This term children will learn about ammonite. Children will revisit some art techniques from the Autumn term, such as cross-hatching and be introduced to different techniques, such as simple line drawing and shading.

The children will also learn how to print using two tones and detail. Along with making sculptures using manipulating and carving clay.



MUSIG

This term children will continue to learn how to play the recorder. They will continue to learn different tunes and how to play these to the right pitch.





SQUELIGE

This term children will learn about forces and magnets. Children will begin with learning about pushing and pulling forces, and to identify these. Next, children will carry out comparative tests to measure frictional forces using force metres; and how to display their findings. Finally, pupils will explore the magnetic attraction, repulsion and magnetic fields.

COMPUTING

This term children will be learning how to use GarageBand. They will learn how to play different musical instruments on the app, and to create a song by layering different musical instruments together.

RE AND PSHE

This term in PSHE, children will be learning about what families are like. They will look at the features, structures of different families and how celebrations are carried out in a family household. In RE, pupils will continue to finish their learning about different religious communities.
