

ENGLISH

This term children will be reading Planet Omar – Accidental Trouble Magnet by Zainab Mian. During reading lessons we will be focusing on retrieval skills and how to accurately find an answer in a text. We will also be reading aloud to ensure that we practise reading fluently and with expression.

In writing, we will be revising the basic skills of writing including what is needed to write good sentences as well as developing our skills in character description.



HISTORY

This term the children will be learning about who the Romans were. They will learn about what life was like as a Roman. We will explore the major events that took place during this time as well as what life was like in Britain before they arrived, what impact they had on Britain and if any of that impacts our lives today.



SCIENCE AND D.T

This term the children will be focusing on the topic 'animals including humans'. During this topic we will be identifying the parts of the digestive system and their purpose and investigating the effects sugary drinks have on teeth.



MATHS

This term the children will be focusing on place value including number lines, rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 and Roman Numerals. We will also be focusing on our timetables consistently so don't forget to practise using TT-Rockstars at home at least three times a week!
