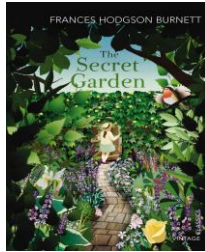


ENGLISH

In reading, we will start our new book of The Secret Garden by Frances Hodgson Burnett and practise the skills of retrieval, inference as well as looking at the new skills of predictions



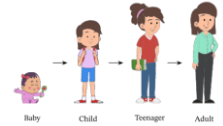
HUMANITIES

This term children will take part in a geography project that teaches them about the features and characteristics of land use in agricultural regions across the world, including a detailed exploration of significant environmental areas. We will focus on land use in the UK, allotments and farming in the UK. To aid our learning we will use maps; grid references; climate zones. We will compare physical features and farming in North and South America to the UK.



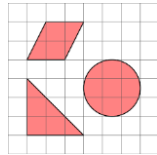
SCIENCE

This term children will learn about animal life cycles, including the human life cycle. They explore human growth and development to old age, including the changes experienced during puberty and human reproduction. We will also look at animal life cycles, stages and processes, classifying mammals. In this unit we will develop the skills of identifying and classifying, pattern seeking and research.



MATHS

This term children will learn about short division and how to use formal method to work out division questions using up to four-digit numbers. After that, we will be recapping multiplication and the formal method up to four-digit multiplying by two-digit numbers. We will move on the area and scaling when we are secure with multiplication. For area we will use cm and meters to measure and solve problems involving area.

THE ARTS

This term children will learn about the genre of land art along with different artists that create this work. They will work outdoors to sketch natural forms and explore the sculptural potential of natural materials before working collaboratively to create land art installations.



COMPUTING
