

# ENGLISH



This term the children will be using our text – ‘The Bear and the Piano’ to develop their reading and writing skills. The skills will include: capital letters and full stops and the use of adjectives to describe a setting/ character. They will be developing their understanding and use of the co-ordinating conjunction for example ‘and’. In reading, the children will develop their understanding of new vocabulary and use simple retrieval through guided reading in small groups.

# HISTORY

This term the children will be learning about the Civil Rights Activist Ruby Bridges. They will learn about her story and the different challenges she faced in the name of equal rights. They will use secondary resources to make comparisons to other civil right activists and learn why their actions had an impact on society as we know it to be today.



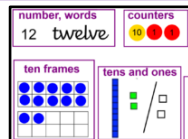
# Heathfield PRIMARY SCHOOL

# SCIENCE

This term the children will be learning about and investigating properties of materials. They will investigate, plan, test and then evaluate their findings. The children will also explore man-made and natural materials using their senses.



# MATHS



This term the children will focus on the topic of place value and number: This will include: counting objects up to 100, writing numbers in words and digits up to 100, sequencing numbers, identifying the value of the digit in a number and recognising the place value of each digit in a two digit number. They will also, represent numbers in different ways and look at calculations within 20.
