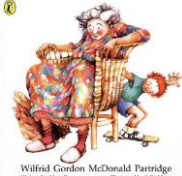


ENGLISH

They will be encouraged to plan their autobiography and sequence events in time order. Children will be focusing on using question marks and full stops in their writing. Along with ending the term by creating their own riddles for their peers to solve.

HUMANITIES

This term children will learn about everyday life and families today. Children will be creating timelines of their own life and will investigate differences and similarities between their life and the 1950s. We will be using a range of resources to make our comparisons such as artefacts.



SCIENCE

This term children are learning that objects are made from materials. They will identify a range of everyday materials and their sources. Children will then investigate the properties of materials and begin to recognise that a material's properties define its use.



MATHS

This term children will learning about inequalities and comparisons, using key vocabulary such as greater than, less than and equal to. We will be further exploring numbers 0-5 and identifying part whole relationships.

The children will also be learning 'Mastery of Number'. In this, they will be consolidating knowledge of odd and even numbers and identifying patterns within numbers.

YEAR 1 AUTUMN TERM 2

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

This term children will learn about the purpose of shelters and their materials. They will name and describe shelters. Before designing and making shelter prototypes. They will be building a play den together as a group for their end product.



P.E

This term children will learning to develop their team building skills by working on listening to others carefully and working together. As well as, completing fitness activities which require developing movement skills, coordination and speed.

MUSIC
