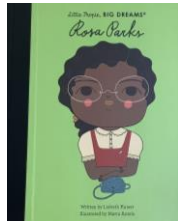


ENGLISH

This term children will focus on learning about Rama and Sita and retelling the story. Then, they will move onto learning about the life and times of Rosa Parks. They will be writing a biography researching the key events that led her to be the great activist she was. Through writing we will be focusing on the skill of using conjunctions (a word which joins two clauses together). Before finally learning about the Wright Brothers and writing informal letters.



HUMANITIES

This term children will focus on significant people throughout history. The children are introduced to vocabulary used to describe the work or actions of significant people, such as activists, artists, explorers, monarchs and scientists. They revisit the concept of chronology and make timelines. There is a focus on Neil Armstrong, Christopher Columbus, Emmeline Pankhurst and Rosa Parks.

SCIENCE

This term children will learn about life cycles and construct their own. They will identify the needs of humans for survival and what they need to be healthy (food groups, importance of exercise: aerobic, strengthening, stretching and balance). An investigation on whether you can improve your fitness will take place. Along with, what are good hygiene practices and how germs are spread.



MATHS

This term children will focus on adding and subtracting two-digit numbers. Children should now be secure on place value of ones and tens. We will be focusing on adding/subtracting from right to left, that is, we start from the ones column and move on to the tens. Once both the columns are calculated, we obtain the final sum. Towards the end of the term, we will move onto multiplication, making equal groups as a means of multiplication.

YEAR 2 AUTUMN TERM 2

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

This term children will learn about the origins of food, about the parts of the plants we eat and food that comes from animal sources. They explore tools used for food preparation and decide which tool is best for as specific task. They discover why some food as cooked and learn to follow a recipe. They make, taste and evaluate their chosen recipe.

COMPUTING

This term children will be using Scratch. They will identify the algorithm in a simple game and suggest improvements. They will identify what makes a game addictive and explain what is their favourite games and why.



P.E

This term children will learn in fundamentals how to balance, run, change direction, jump, hop and skip while assessing their own and their peers strengths. In dance, they will learn about space and how their body can move to express an idea, mood, character or feeling.

MUSIC

This term children will start to learn to play the recorder. They will focus on playing in time to the music along with playing for the correct length of the note. They are learning B and A note.

RE AND PSHE

This term children will learn about responding to suffering through the story of Jairus' daughter, the work of Birmingham City Mission, the Prophet's use of miracles and the work of Islamic Relief. They are also learning about sharing and being generous through Christmas and the Prophet Isa. In PSHE, what is bullying and what we can do about it.
