

ENGLISH

This term children will be reading the class texts Gargling with Jelly, where they have class discussions and make opinions on a variety of poems. They will also be reading How Winston Delivered Christmas. They will learn about inferring feelings, thoughts and motives from a text or an image. In writing, children will be revisiting their punctuation skills before using a wider range of conjunctions, noun phrases and similes to write different text types based on our class text.



HUMANITIES

This term children will learn about British prehistory from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, including changes to people and lifestyle caused by ingenuity, invention and technological advancement. They will be introduced to the Bell Beaker Folk, develop their understanding of wealth and power, and look at how the Bronze Age could of ended.

SCIENCE

This term children will learn about the importance of nutrition for humans and other animals. They will develop their understanding on carnivores, herbivores and omnivores diets. Year 3 will also learn about the role of a skeleton and muscles along with identifying animals with different types of skeletons.



MATHS

This term children will continue to develop their knowledge on numbers to 1000, learning about different measurements and how to convert measurements accurately. Year 3 will also look at adding and subtracting across 10 efficiently. Pupils should continue to practise their times tables (10x, 2x, 5x, 3x, 4x and 8x).

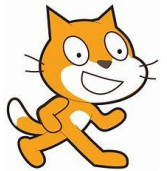
DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

This term children will learn about food groups and the Eatwell guide. They learn about methods of cooking and explore these by cooking potatoes and ratatouille. The children will choose and make a taco filling according to specific design criteria.



COMPUTING

This term children will learn how to design and create their own block code animation on Scratch. They will look at what an animation is and how to sequence instructions.



P.E

This term children in 3B will improve on key skills used in dodgeball such as throwing, dodging and catching. Pupils in 3G will focus on improving the quality of their gymnastic movements and developing their confidence to perform different movements and shapes.

MUSIC

This term children will continue to learn different notes and songs on the recorders, focusing on the beat and pitch.
