

ENGLISH

This term in writing the children have been learning about the poetic form of Kennings. They practised creating Kennings of their own based on the theme of Anglo-Saxons. Next, they will learn about the features of non-chronological reports and write a report based on the topic Invasion. In class the children are reading in a book called Anglo Saxon Boy. They have used this text to help them revise and enhance their skills in inference, prediction, summarising and word level work linked to their weekly spellings.



MATHS

This term children will learn about the algorithms of addition and subtraction. They have considered different strategies for solving subtraction questions. Also, they've been building on their understanding of solving worded problems. Next, they will be working on the topic of perimeter, where they will measure perimeter of regular and irregular shapes.

Times table focus: 3, 6 and 9.

P.E

They will be learning all about the following sports:
4R – Handball. Skills: catching and throwing skills, moving with the ball as well as dribbling and shooting.

4W – Gymnastics. Skills: individual and partner balance, barrel, forward, straddle and straight roll.



HUMANITIES

This term children will learn about Invasion. The key learning will be linked to the time of the Anglo Saxons. They will explore what life was like in Britain during this time period, what have the discoveries of this period taught us about that civilization and consider the impact of the Viking raids at the time. The children will develop the skill of enquiry questioning and analysing of primary and secondary resources.



YEAR 4 AUTUMN TERM 2

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

This term children will learn about fresh food and good food. The children will develop their knowledge and understanding of how food can be kept fresh, analyse food packaging, test and create a healthy snack.



MUSIC

This term children will learn how to play the musical instrument called a Nuvo Dood. The music specialist teacher will teach the children how to manage and play various notes in tune.



SCIENCE

This term children will learn all about sound. In this topic they will learn about the parts of an ear and how sound travels. They will consider volume and pitch in sounds. They will explore how sounds travel and develop their understanding of vibrations.



COMPUTING

This term children will learn... how to use XL documents to create tables and analyse data. They will also use this program to generate graphs based on the data they have collated.



RE AND PSHE

In RE the children will learn about Prince Siddharta and his influence on the Buddhist faith. They will also learn about how be curious and develop a value of knowledge linked Christianity and other faiths. In PSHE, the children will learn about human protected characteristic, how they link to children's rights, and develop a broader understanding of tolerance and respect.
