

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Children will begin to join in with repeated refrains and anticipate key events and phrases in rhymes and traditional stories. Children will begin to show an understanding of prepositions such as: 'under', 'on top' and 'behind' by carrying out an action or selecting the correct picture.

They will be encouraged to use more complex sentences and elaborate to link thoughts. Also, they will apply new vocabulary learned in their play.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

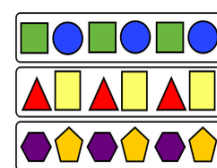
The children will be developing their knowledge and understanding of the world through exploring our outdoor environment and talking about how the environment has changed during the year. We will be planting a range of vegetables and flowers. The children will learn the basic structure of a plant. They will also be learning about the life cycle of a chick, their hatching process and how they are looked after.



MATHS

Children will be learning how to recite number names in sequence through number rhymes and daily counting.

Children will problem solve by completing simply jigsaw puzzles. They will also begin to represent numbers in mark making. They will start to understand an ABAB pattern and continue a simple repeated pattern.



LITERACY

This term, the children will be focusing on the project, 'Once Upon a Time' and exploring traditional texts such as, The Gingerbread Man and The Three Little Pigs. Children will be able to recognise familiar logos and signs in the environment. Attention would also be given to phase 1 phonics and general sound discrimination in the environment. Children will also be able to copy some of the letters in their name without a name card.



NURSERY SPRING TERM 2

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

In Nursery, the children will explore different techniques to join materials. They will also be exploring different instruments and make up their own rhythms. They will be exploring how sounds can be changed. Children will be learning how to operate ICT equipment and learn how to operate Bee-Bots and Spheros.



PSED

Children in Nursery will begin to show confidence in asking adults for help and communicate freely about their own home and community. They will adapt behaviour to different events, social situations and changes in routine. Children will be encouraged to play in a group as well as extending and elaborating play ideas and initiating play.



P.E

This term, the children will be encouraged to move freely with confidence while balancing, jumping and hopping.

Children will begin to draw lines and circles using gross motor skills and partake in write dance. They will use one handed tools and equipment, using scissors to cut out shapes.
