# HUMANITIES

The children will carry out fieldwork tasks to identify characteristics of their local area. They will begin to identify features and landmarks on an aerial photograph and use simple directional language to give directions and describe the location of features and discuss where things are in relation to each other.

# SCIENCE

This term, children will continue learning about the weather and events associated with each season. They will investigate weather using toys, models or simple equipment and collate the data in a variety of ways. They will be encouraged to ask simple scientific questions and predict what they might think will happen. The children will also follow instructions to perform simple tests.



# MATHS

This term, children will continue to look at additive structures. The children will learn how to write a number sentence. They will also be focusing on addition and subtraction facts within 10. Furthermore, they will be looking at doubling and halving facts and the similarities between the two.

# DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

This term, the children will explore the topic 'Taxi'. They will learn about wheels, axles and chassis and how they work together to make a vehicle move. The children will then design, make and evaluate their vehicle.



# COMPUTING

This term, children will be learning about being storytellers using ICT. They will explore bringing together a variety of tools and techniques into one application (project). The children will use sound and pictures to produce their own talking eBook.



# P.E

This term, children will be developing their ball skills. They will be working individually and in pairs. The children will explore fundamental ball skills of throwing, catching, rolling and dribbling.



# MUSIC

This term children will be learning the song 'Round and Round'. They will use the glockenspiels to support their music lessons and begin to use up to 3 notes to play along with the song.

# RE AND PSHE

This term in PSHE the children will learn about money. They will learn what money is and how it is obtained, how people make choices about what to do with their money and the difference between needs and wants. In RE, we will be looking at the dispositions: 'being courageous and confident' and 'being loyal and steadfast'.
