EUGLISU

In reading children will be looking at a non-fiction text called Coasts (Let's Explore Britain). The focus of reading lessons will be vocabulary and word reading skills. They will be recapping retrieval skills using the texts and answering a variety of question. They will then learn how to use strategies to read harder

strategies to read harder words and learn how to decode what the word means. In writing, they will be learning to write for effect a character description, narrative and poem.



MATUS:

This term children will learn how to add and subtract two-digit numbers efficiently. They will learn how to partition numbers to help them add and subtract numbers. They will then move onto fractions, learning how to find $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, and $\frac{1}{4}$ of objects, shapes and amounts.

This term children are starting their gymnastics topic. They will be learning how to jump, leap, turn and some basic tumbling passes.



HUMANITIES
