



ENGLISH

This term, the children will continue to read the text, 'King of the Cloud Forests' by Michael Morpurgo. Their reading and writing lessons will be linked mainly to this text. In writing, year 4 will learn how to: write an explanation text as well as a recount. In reading, the children will develop their retrieval, inference, summarising and prediction skills. They will read the text within reading lessons with the class teacher. Children are also expected to read their class/library books at home and have parent comments written daily into their journals.

MATHS

This term children will continue learning about manipulating and using multiplication and division efficiently. They will continue to learn and practice strategies for reciting and using their timetables when responding to mathematical problems. They should know all their tables facts up to 12x12 and must practice regularly at home. They will finish this half term by learning to use co-ordinates to plot shapes.

PE

4R – In PE we will be covering Outdoor Adventure Activities, learning how to problem solve, communicate effectively and work as a team.
4W – This half term we will be learning to play handball, learning passing, dribbling and moving with the ball, as well as teamwork and planning strategies.

HUMANITIES

This half term the children will continue to have a geography focus in humanities. They will learn about the characteristics and features of mountain



ranges around the world, including a detailed exploration of the ecosystems and processes that shape them and the land around them.

YEAR 4 SPRING TERM 2

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

This term children will learn about home furnishings and the significant designer William Morris. We will learn techniques for decorating fabric, including block printing, hemming and embroidery and use them to design and make a fabric sample



MUSIC

This half term children will continue to learn how to play the Nuvo Dood. The music specialist teacher will teach the children various compositions and support their development.

SCIENCE

This term, children will be learning how to classify living things and creating classification keys to identify living things. We will be looking at the animal and plant kingdoms. In addition, we will be using skills of identification and classification and carrying out research.



COMPUTING

RE AND PSHE

They will learn about applying basic first aid, when it's important to use first aid and how to seek adult support. As well as understanding the importance of remaining calm and responding appropriately.
