

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Children will learn new vocabulary related to flowers and minibeasts. They will also apply and use this vocabulary in their play when exploring. They will also communicate with their friends with back to fourth exchanges and keep a conversation going. Children will begin to understand alliteration and begin to hear the same sound.



UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

The children will be exploring the natural world around them. They will explore minibeasts and their habitats, as well as a range of flowers and their colours. Nursery will learn how to do planting in steps. Children will also begin to understand shadows can appear in the sunshine.



MATHS

The children will begin to represent numbers in mark making. They will also compare quantities to 10, knowing which has more and which has less and when quantities are the same. Children will use sequential language when ordering events. For example, first, then, next. Children will continue a simple repeated pattern, such as ladybird, spider, ladybird, spider.



LITERACY

This term, the children will be reading a range of fiction and non fiction books, such as The Hungry Caterpillar and My First Book of Garden Bugs. Children will use pictures to tell a story. Children will also role play key events in familiar stories. Children to name different parts of a book e.g. front cover, back cover, title and blurb.



NURSERY SUMMER TERM 1

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

In Nursery, the children will explore different technique to join materials. They will also be exploring different tuned and untuned instruments and make up their own rhythms. They will be exploring how sounds can be changed.



PSED

The children will be able to talk about healthy and unhealthy food choices and understand how the food choice affects our bodies. Children will also learn how to take care of minibeasts and what they need to survive. Children will begin to understand the importance of working together as a team to complete a given task.

This term in PE, children will be developing their ball skills through the topic of 'minibeasts'. Children will learn skills, such as rolling, receiving, throwing, bouncing and kicking. They will begin to understand what a team player is.
