

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

This term the children will be learning further songs, such as Big Bear Funk! We will also spend time revisiting and singing our favourite nursery rhymes such as Five Little Monkeys.

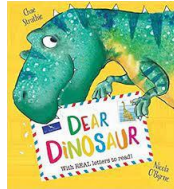


They will be delving into prehistoric times and learning new vocabulary linked to our topic 'Dangerous Dinosaurs'. Also, they will learn to describe and retell stories involving dinosaurs in some detail.

LITERACY

This term the children will be learning about dinosaurs through non fiction texts and using adjectives to describe the dinosaurs.

Using the text 'Dear Dinosaur', children will develop their letter writing skills.



Children will focus on writing recognisable letters and using clear finger spaces between words.

P.E

This term the children will be learning to develop and refine a range of ball skills. They will develop confidence, competence, precision and accuracy when engaging in activities that involve a ball. Also, children will learn to show increasing control when throwing catching and kicking a ball.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

This term the children will be learning to understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling. They will learn about the changing seasons as we settle into spring and then move into summer, by exploring the natural world around them and describing what they see, hear and feel whilst outside.



RECEPTION SUMMER TERM 1

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

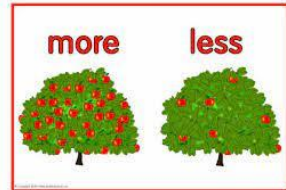


This term the children will be learning to be creative with a range of different materials, such as paints, chalks, charcoal and pastels. They will explore cave painting and use chalks and pastels to create their own with their favourite prehistoric animals.

They will use their learning on different artistic materials to create and make props and resources to support imaginative play.

MATHS

This term the children will be learning more and less. Through practical activities and games, the children will use reason about numbers and think carefully about which is more or less. They will use linear number tracks to play games that will encourage them to compare numbers that are far apart, near and next to each other.



The children will also consolidate and deepen their understanding of the composition of numbers to 10.

PSED

This term the children will be learning to explain the reasons for rules, knowing right from wrong.

Through activities in their learning environment, they will learn to show resilience and perseverance in the face of a challenge.

The children will learn to develop their concentration and their listening skills, by giving focused attention to what someone else is saying. This will be with both adults and their peers.
