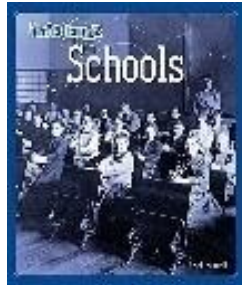


ENGLISH

This term the class text will be 'Schools'. The text will help them explore what school was like in the past over many decades. It will also inspire the children's writing. The children will be learning to create narratives within a familiar settings with the purpose to inform and entertain.

Following this, they will also learn how to write letters. The children will look at the key features, how to format a letter, the different writing styles of a letter and what effect is should have on it's reader.



MATHS

This term, children will be looking at counting efficiently in groups of two, five and ten. They will also be looking at money, its value and how to make different amounts using: 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p. They will use their knowledge of money to do some problem solving.



P.E

This term, children will be introduced to the skills required for invasion games. They use sending, receiving and dribbling to explore the ideas of attacking and defending.



HUMANITIES

In this history project is called 'School Days' and will be for the whole of Summer Term. It teaches children about their own school and locality, both today and in the past. They compare schooling in the Victorian era to their experiences today.

In term 1, we will focus on what our school was like in the past, what it is like now, where is our school and who is important to our school. Before half term, we will start to look at the Victorian era.



YEAR 1 SUMMER TERM 1

ART

This term, the children will explore the topic 'Street View'. They will be introduced to relief sculpture and mural making. The children will observe their local buildings and draw sketches from their observations. They will look at the artist James Rizzi and his artistic techniques. The children will then work collaboratively to complete a relief mural of their local community in the style of James Rizzi.

MUSIC

This term children will be looking at the topic 'Your Imagination' They will learn to sing, improve by using their voice and instruments. They will then compose their own music using instruments.

SCIENCE

This term, children will looking at the topic 'Plant Parts'. They will identify and classify wild plants and choose one to study for their project. The children will learn about the changes in plants brought about by seasonal changes.

They will learn about plant parts, demonstrating their learning by labelling and drawing plants. They will also learn about seeds and bulbs and how they grow into new plants



COMPUTING

This term, children will use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. The children see word art daily, but never have a chance to design their own.

In this unit children will learn how to use and create their own word art that is unique to them.



RE AND PSHE

This term in PSHE the children will learn about 'people who keep us safe'. They will learn about the different people in our community that help us, and explore what to do if they feel unsafe or worried. They will also learn about the 'pants rule'. In RE, we will be looking at the dispositions: 'remembering roots' and 'being hopeful and visionary'
