

ENGLISH

During reading lessons, pupils will be looking at the book *Who Let the Gods Out*. We will revise skills in retrieval and inference, making sure pupils can answer a range of questions about these in SAT's format. We will also look at summarising and evaluating the authors choice of language.



In writing, we will be writing a narrative, diary and one-sided argument. We will be focusing on a range of skills and ensuring our writing is interesting, ambitious and creative. We will use the book *Who Let the Gods out* and our Greek humanities work to inspire our writing using characterisation.

MATHS

During this half term, pupils will be learning about fractions This will including multiplying fractions including mixed number fractions, comparing fractions and representing fractions in different ways. We will be focusing on ensuring pupils have a solid understanding and knowledge base and are able to represent fractions in different ways. We will start with learning about the geography of ancient Greece and move on to an in-depth series of lessons about the city state of Athens, thinking about culture, society and famous Athenians.

ART

This term in art the pupils will be focusing on expression. This project teaches children about the Expressionist art movement and the 'Father of Expressionism', Edvard Munch. They explore different ways to portray feelings and emotions in art to create an imaginative self-portrait.



MUSIC

We will play along to *Make You Feel My Love* by Adele. We will be playing the glockenspiels learning about notation, timing, musicality, improvising and composing.



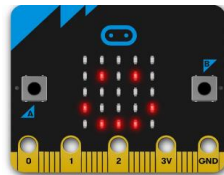
SCIENCE

This term in science we will be looking at forces and mechanisms. The children will learn about the forces of gravity, air resistance and frictions. The children will explore the effects of these. They will learn about mechanisms, their uses and how they allow a smaller effort to have a great effect. The children will take part in some experiments to help them predict, observe, measure, record and conclude.



COMPUTING

Pupils will explore how and why data is stored and how it's used. Pupils will then learn to program a micro:bit and design different programs to test the capabilities of the micro:bit. Putting into place coding and learning how this can relate to real world situations.



RE AND PSHE

In PSHE, pupils will be learning health and wellbeing including drugs, alcohol and tobacco and the risks that come with them as well as effective ways to manage the risks. In RE, pupils will be learning about being temperate, self-discipline and seeking contentment. Then, about living with integrity.
