NAMES IN CLOTHES



As we move into the final half term of the academic year, and jumpers, cardigans and jackets are often taken off throughout the day, please remember to name all items of clothing and outerwear to ensure we can return items if they are accidentally misplaced.

SWIMMING SUCSESSES

The children in Year 5 have had a fantastic 2 weeks of swimming daily. There has been a huge amount of progress seen and the swimming instructor and coaches have been extremely complimentary about the bravery, attitudes and perseverance shown from the children. The fortnight in figures:

- 6 pupils are now swimming 25 meters or more
- 3 pupils able to perform self water safety (assessed)
- 32% pupils are now swimming 11-24 meters—this is great progress
- 61% pupils progressed from non-swimmers
- 47% pupils progressed to School Swim Award Level 3
- 23% pupils classed as non swimmers are now able to swim 5 meters unaided.
- And last but by no means least, 1 pupil progressed through all of the School Swim Awards! This is a phenomenal achievement - well done Esa!
