

# COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Children will engage in conversations about stories and explore meanings of new words they learn from the topics.

They will be encouraged to question why things happen to develop their knowledge and give explanations to their answers when questioned.

Children will be playing a range of phonics games and play this together with their friends.



# UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

The children will be exploring maps and their job. They will also be exploring a variety of wild and domestic animals, as well as sea creatures. Children will learn about showing care for living things and the environment.

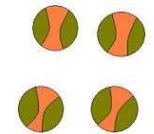
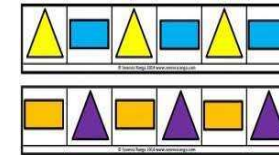
Children will say how two places in the environment are similar or different.



# MATHS

The children will link numerals and amounts, showing the right number of fingers or objects that match the numeral up to 5. They will also be looking at properties of a shape.

Children will be comparing quantities to 10, knowing which group has more and which has less and also quantities that are the same. Children will learn repeated patterns with shapes and objects.



# LITERACY

Children will give meaning to what they draw, paint or write. They will learn different genres of writing. E.g.: postcards for sending messages to someone that usually has an illustration/ photo on the side.

Children will be exploring using all their senses with a hands on exploration of natural materials. Children will begin to sing the melody, pitch and tone of well-known nursery rhymes and songs. Children will be learning about the importance of looking after our environment and what we can do to make changes.
